## TAP STUDENTS

Follow either the ballet OR jazz dress codes Black Flat Tap Shoes IMPORTANT NOTE: Tap shoes worn outside MAY NOT be used in our studio!

\*Advanced students have earned the privilege of a more colorful dress code\* \*Ballet students may not wear warm-ups or black tights over pink tights during class.\*

- Dancers MUST WEAR A BUNCOVER!!! In addition to the buncover, bobby pins must be used. This is not optional!
- No panties should be worn under tights and no jewelry should be worn in class.
- A black sports bra is the only acceptable bra that can be worn under leotards.
- Leotards MUST be worn under T- shirts (females).
- Dancers must wear a cover-up (top and bottom) when entering and leaving the school.

## **RULES**

It is our intention to provide the very highest standard of dance training in a clean and attractive facility. We ask for your cooperation in fulfilling this goal. We thank you for your support!

- No eating, drinking, smoking, or gum chewing is allowed in the studio. THIS APPLIES TO EVERYONE!
- All clothes, shoes, bags, coats, etc. should be placed in the cubbyholes. Do not leave your "stuff" on the floor or in the restrooms.
- Students should use the restroom before class begins. Sit quietly in the lobby while waiting for your class. DO NOT play in the restrooms!
- BE PUNCTUAL. Dancers WILL NOT be able to enter class after the 15 minute mark. At any age, disruptions delay the class. The risk of injury is much higher if a dancer is not properly warmed up. In case of absence or tardiness, check your Parent Portal for an appropriate make-up class. Class duration will vary. Most classes run approximately 55 minutes.
- Dancers should be picked up promptly after class. A fee of \$30.00 will be charged if Dancin' School staff is required to stay beyond closing time. For safety reasons, dancers waiting to be picked up must wait inside the school. Please do not ask your dancer to wait for you outside.
- Please check your email and BAND app regularly for announcements. This is the only way that we are able to communicate our vital information to you.

<u>PERFORMANCES</u>: Dancin' School's Annual Revue is held each spring. This performance opportunity is optional and is available to every student (participation is encouraged). <u>Costume fees are non-refundable</u>. The family performance fee is \$165.00 for the first show and \$75 per each additional show. You will also receive four (4) tickets to each show in which your child is featured and a downloadable version of each show. All new parents must attend a Parent Meeting for the annual end of year show or your child will not be able to participate.
